

Indirect Questions

An indirect question is a question embedded in a sentence, therefore it isn't direct.
It's used to be polite, to ask for favours and requests and is very similar to the structure of reported speech.

The structures are...

With Question Word	Yes/No
Question phrase + question word* + subject + verb *+ adjective / + noun	Question phrase + if + subject + verb
Question phrase + question word + subject + modal verb + infinitive verb	Question phrase + if + subject + modal verb + infinitive
Question phrase + question word + subject + auxiliary verb + second verb	Question phrase + if + subject + auxiliary verb + second verb



LOOK OUT

- ⚠ Don't use a question mark
- ⚠ Be aware of word order
- ⚠ Watch out for whether and if
- ⚠ Replace subjects with "to"
- ⚠ "Who" can be a subject
