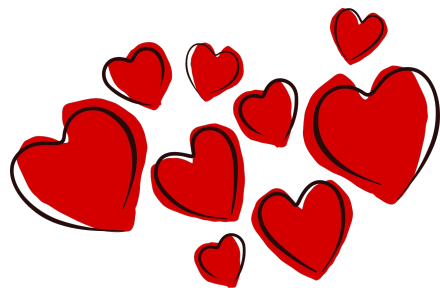




Relationships

There are so many unique types of relationships and many people try to avoid labels. However, today we're going to review typical vocabulary to discuss some relationships and stages within those relationships.



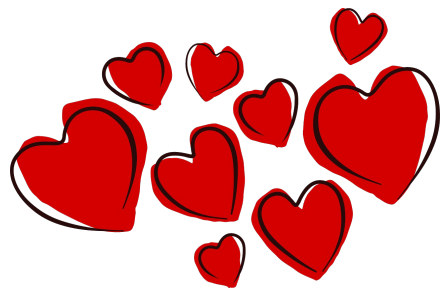
Dating

- He's my boyfriend

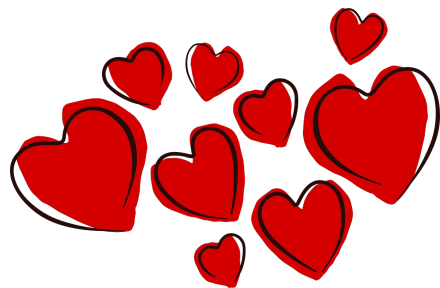

- ⇒ I kiss him/her

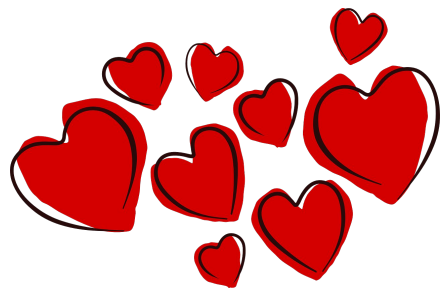


Serious Commitment
