EXERCISE A

What is an adverb of time?

A word that answers the questions “when”, “how long” or “how often”.

EXERCISE B

What is the typical position of an adverb of time?

At the end of a sentence.

EXERCISE C

Why could an adverb of time be placed at the beginning of a sentence?

To place emphasis on the time of the event.

EXERCISE D

What are the three types of adverbs of time? Provide one example of each.

1. **When?** E.g. → **Tomorrow**
2. **How long?** E.g. → **For two hours**
3. **How often?** E.g. → **Often**

EXERCISE E

What is the difference between an adverb of time and an adverb of frequency?

Adverbs of frequency focus on how regularly the event happens. These are typically placed before the verb. Adverbs of time focus on when the event happens. These are typically placed at the end of the sentence.
