Read each sentence then identify the function of the word in bold. What is the speaker trying to express - ability, request, permission, suggestion, possibility, success/failure, skill.

- 1. I can play the guitar really well.

  General ability/skill in the present tense.
- 2. **Could** you help me carry these bags? *Polite request*.
- 3. Sorry, I **couldn't** finish the report yesterday.

  Specific past inability/failure. You could also use "was't able to".
- 4. I'll **be able to** join the meeting tomorrow. *Formal future ability.*
- 5. You **can** borrow my car if you need it. *Informal permission*.
- 6. When I was younger, I **could** run very fast. *General ability/skill in the past tense.*
- 7. I'm not sure, but we **could** go see a movie tonight.

  Polite suggestion and hypothetical plan for the future.
- 8. He was able to solve the problem after hours of work. Specific past success.
- 9. **Can** you open the window, please? *Informal request*.



10. I've never **been able to** eat spicy food.

Present perfect inability.

11. Could I ask you a personal question?

Polite formal request.

12. She **can't** swim very well.

General inability/skill in the present tense.

13. We  ${\bf can}$  see the mountains from here on a clear day.

Present possibility.

14.1 **could** hear someone calling my name outside.

General ability/perception in the past tense.

15. They will be able to finish the project before the deadline.

Future ability/success.
