



Question Transformation **Answers**

Transform the words given into a question and use the task to create a specific type of question. **Please note, these answers are suggestions.**

1.

Prompt: you / go / weekend / where?

Task: Form a correct wh-question in past simple.

Answer: Where did you go at the weekend?

2.

Prompt: she / arrive / yet?

Task: Form a correct negative question in present perfect.

Answer: Hasn't she arrived yet?

3.

Prompt: Could you tell me / John / leave / office / when?

Task: Form a correct indirect question.

Answer: Could you tell me when John leaves the office?

4.

Prompt: they / finished / the project?

Task: Form a correct yes/no question in present perfect.

Answer: Have they finished the project?

5.

Prompt: You / meet / the new manager / haven't you?

Task: Form a correct tag question.

Answer: You've met the new manager, haven't you?

6.

Prompt: he / can / help / me / ?

Task: Form a correct yes/no question using a modal verb.

Answer: Can he help me?

7.

Prompt: she / attend / the meeting / if / available?

Task: Form a correct conditional question.

Answer: Would she attend the meeting if she were available?

8.

Prompt: you / like / coffee or tea?

Task: Form a restrictive choice question.

Answer: Do you prefer coffee or tea?

9.

Prompt: the train / leave / at 9:30?

Task: Form a direct yes/no question in present simple.

Answer: Does the train leave at 9:30?

10.

Prompt: Why / she / look / so tired?

Task: Form a wh-question in present continuous.

Answer: Why is she looking so tired?

11.

Prompt: Could you tell me / he / enjoy / the film?

Task: Transform into an indirect question.

Answer: Could you tell me if he enjoyed the film?

12.

Prompt: They / not reply / yet / have they?

Task: Form a correct negative question with tag.

Answer: They haven't replied yet, have they?

13.

Prompt: Where / she / go / last summer?

Task: Form a direct wh-question in past simple.

Answer: Where did she go last summer?

14.

Prompt: you / meet / my colleague / ?

Task: Form a polite yes/no indirect question.

Answer: Could you tell me if you've met my colleague?

15.

Prompt: He / start / the course / hasn't he?

Task: Form a tag question.

Answer: He's started the course, hasn't he?
