intransitive

to enter - establish a connection

I always log in to my computer in the morning.

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to check out

intransitive

to make payment on an online site

You need to accept T&Cs when you check out.

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to sign up

intransitive / transitive-separable

to register

This class looks good so I will sign up.

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to shop around

intransitive

to look at lots of prices/shops before buying

I always shop around for the best deal.

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to try on

transitive - separable

to put some clothing on your body before buying it

You can try clothes on in the changing rooms.

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to put on

transitive - separable

to put some clothing on your body

Can you put your jumper on, please?

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to take off

transitive - separable

to remove some clothing on your body

Take your shoes off before you come into the house!

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to nip out

intransitive

to leave your location for a short time

I'm going to nip out to the garden.

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to pop into

transitive - inseparable

to visit for a short time

Shall we pop into town later?

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to pick out

transitive - separable

to choose

What did you pick out for tonight?

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to stand out

intransitive

to be noticeable

That dress really stands out ... it's bright orange!

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to pay for

transitive - inseparable

to give money in exchange for a product/service

Can you pay for this meal?

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to queue up

intransitive

to wait in a queue

I hate queueing up for the changing rooms!

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to bring down

transitive - separable

to reduce

They never bring the prices down for this necklace.

Phrasal Verbs for Online Shopping

to sell out

intransitive

to sell all the available stock

We sold out of tickets!
