intransitive / transitive-separable

to register

to shop around

intransitive

to look at lots of prices/shops before buying

I always shop around for the best deal.



to try on

transitive - separable

to put some clothing on your body before buying it

You can try clothes on in the changing rooms.



to put on

transitive - separable

to put some clothing on your body

Can you put your jumper on, please?



to take off

transitive - separable

to remove some clothing on your body

Take your shoes off before you come into the house!



to nip out

intransitive

to leave your location for a short time

I'm going to nip out to the garden.



to pop into

transitive - inseparable

to visit for a short time

Shall we pop into town later?



to pick out

transitive - separable

to choose

What did you pick out for tonight?



to stand out

intransitive

to be noticeable

That dress really stands out ... it's bright orange!



to pay for

transitive - inseparable

to give money in exchange for a product/service

Can you pay for this meal?



to queue up

intransitive

to wait in a queue

I hate queueing up for the changing rooms!



to bring down

transitive - separable

to reduce

They never bring the prices down for this necklace.



to sell out

intransitive

to sell all the available stock

We sold out of tickets!
