You're meeting a new colleague. Ask 3 questions about their job role, background and work experience.



You're asking for directions. Ask for the nearest station, street or landmark.



You're shopping for clothes. Ask the sales assistant 4 questions about item size, price, materials and discounts.



You're ordering food in a restaurant. Ask 3 questions about the menu, ingredients and specials.

You're at a job interview. Ask 3 questions about the company, responsibilities and expectations.



You're talking to a friend about last weekend. Ask them about their activities, plans and experience.



You're asking for help with technology. Ask the assistant how to use the apps, devices and how to solve a technical problem.



You're booking a hotel room. Ask 3 questions about the availability, prices and amenities.



You're meeting somebody at a networking event. Ask somebody about their profession, interests and recent projects.



You're asking for travel advice at a travel agents. Ask about flights, local transport and sightseeing tips.



You're discussing hobbies and free time with your family. Ask 3 questions about sports, reading and creative activities.



You're talking to your English teacher. Ask about your next lesson, assignment and food feedback.



You're interviewing your grandparents. Ask 3 questions about their childhood memories.



You're planning a group project. Ask 3 questions about deadline, tasks and responsibilities.
