intransitive

transitive - inseparable

To keep money to buy something

I'm saving up for a house deposit.

to splash out on

transitive - inseparable

To spend money without worrying

On Saturdays, I splash out on my shopping trips.

Phrasal Verbs for Money

to cut back (on)

transitive - inseparable

To spend less money

I'll cut back on my food bills.

Phrasal Verbs for Money

to get by (on)

intransitive

transitive - inseparable

To have enough money to live

We get by on £400/month

Phrasal Verbs for Money

to chip in

intransitive

To contribute money to others

We all chipped in at the restaurant.

Phrasal Verbs for Money

to go up

intransitive

To increase

Prices are going up at the moment.

Phrasal Verbs for Money

to go down

intransitive

To decrease

Inflation is going down.

Phrasal Verbs for Money

to cash out

intransitive

transitive - separable

To sell out an investment

I cashed out my savings.

Phrasal Verbs for Money

to take out

intransitive

transitive - separable

To withdraw money

We took out a loan.

Phrasal Verbs for Money

to pay back

transitive - separable

To give money to somebody you borrowed from

I'll pay you back later!

Phrasal Verbs for Money

to pay off

transitive - separable

To give all the money to somebody you borrowed from

I've finally paid off my loan.

Phrasal Verbs for Money

to rip off

transitive - separable

To charge too much money

They ripped us off at the shop.
