Common Mistakes



I'm learning English for 4 years

The keyword “for” as a time phrase can't be used in the present continuous tense.

for 4 years

I'm waiting for the bus since 3 o'clock.

The keyword “since” as a time phrase can't be used in the present continuous tense.

I've been waiting for the bus
since 3 o'clock.
