

## Intonation

Intonation is the rise and all of your voice when you speak. It conveys emotion, attitude and intention when speaking in English. It can be used alongside stress and rhythm to sound native when speaking.

Rising Intonation	Falling Intonation	Fall-Rising Intonation
Statements My name is Hannah.	Yes/no questions Are you ready?	Politeness I could help
Commands Sit down!	Uncertainty You're free tomorrow?	Hesitation  Maybe we should wait?
WH-questions Where are you going?	Surprise You saw him?	Doubt I think it's OK



## LOOK OUT

- $\ensuremath{\triangle}$  Tag questions rise when genuinely asking and fall when expecting agreement
- $\triangle$  Each item on a list rises and the last item falls
- **△** Contrast emphasis fall-rises
