














- 1. I always have a shower in the morning
- 2. Sometimes, I read a book
- 3. I never go to school at 8pm
- 4. He seldom visits me



We can use the word "every" to talk about a regular event at the same time.

EVERY + TIME PERIOD

Every day
Every week
Every year



Or we can express a specific number of times that we do something.

QUANTITY + A + TIME PERIOD



QUANTITY + A + TIME PERIOD

Once a week
Twice a day
Three times a year



We are going to learn 5 rules for the position of adverbs of frequency





FA goes before the main verb

Subject

Adverb of Frequency

Definite FA goes at the beginning or end

Definite Frequency Adverbs





FA goes in between the auxiliary verb and main verb

Auxiliary Verb Adverb of Frequency

In questions, we flip the subject and first verb

Review





Rule	Structure	Example
Before the main verb	subject + FA + verb	I always dance
Definite adverb of frequency	FA + subject + verb subject + verb + FA	Three times a week, I dance I dance three times a week
With an auxiliary verb	subject + auxiliary + FA + verb	I am always dancing I don't usually dance
Questions	verb + subject + FA + extra	Do you always smoke? Are you always smoking?
Verb to be	subject + verb to be + FA + verb	You are usually happy
