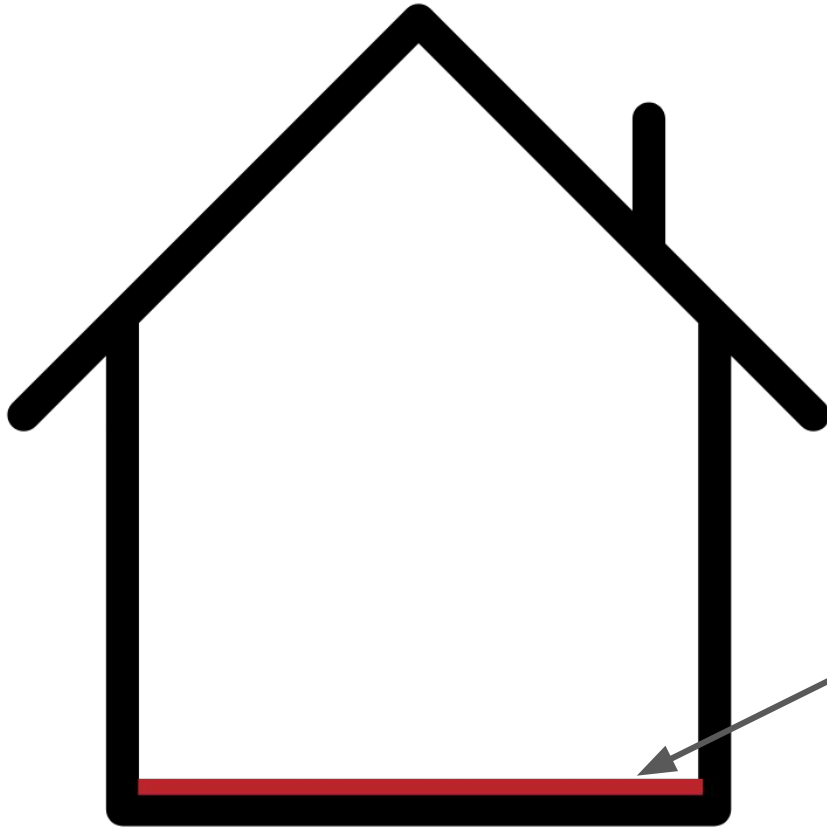

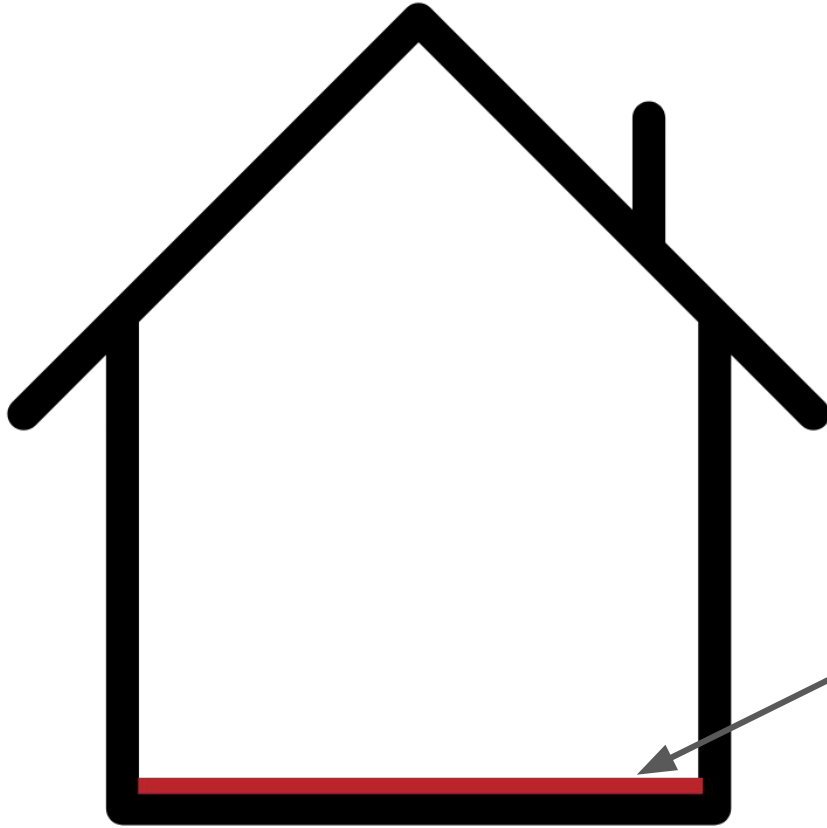
The **floor** is the part

Carpet



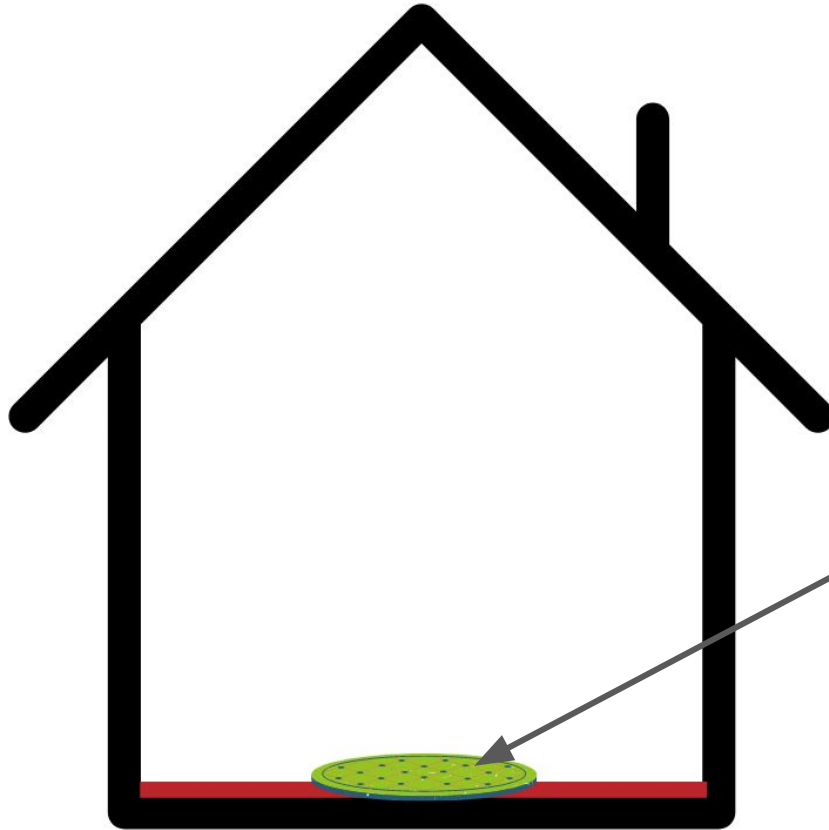
What is the material

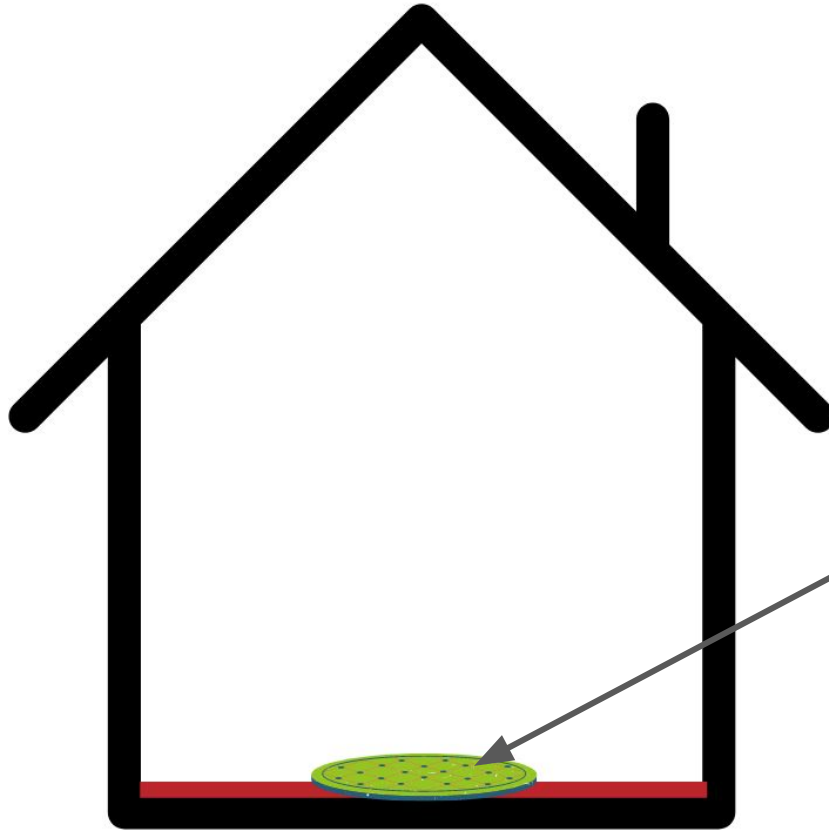
If there is a material on the floor that is soft, this is a **carpet**. A carpet is material in an entire room.
