


Let's start with the basics...





Let's keep going to 10!













You can see that we normally add "TEEN" to the end of the basic number.

11	Eleven	16	Sixteen
12	Twelve	17	Seventeen
13	Thirteen	18	Eighteen
14	Fourteen	19	Nineteen
15	Fifteen	20	Twenty

But there are a few exceptions! Some words are completely different!

From the numbers 21-99, there are always two parts.

Now you know both parts and we need to put them together.



All numbers between 21 and 99 need a hyphen in between the two parts.

E.g. 67
sixty-seven

This hyphen is really important!



The first part is the 0 number


Part 1	Part 2

And the second part is the basic number






The number 62 is written;

sixty-two








The number 83 is written;
