



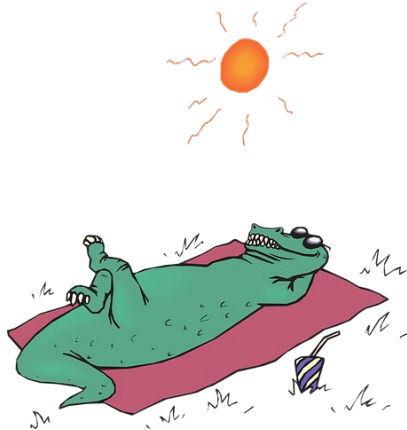

If you sit in the sun for 10 hours, you will burn.

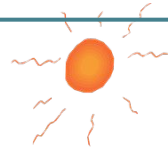

First Conditional

EVENT A

If you are good,

EVENT B

I will buy you some sweets

Promises



First Conditional

EVENT A

If you help me,

EVENT B

I will help you do your homework

Persuade



First Conditional

EVENT A

If it rains,

EVENT B

we will have the party inside

Plans



First Conditional

If + present simple

If it rains,

will + infinitive

we will have the party inside



First Conditional

If + present simple

won't + infinitive

If you are naughty,

Santa won't deliver presents



First Conditional

won't + infinitive

Santa won't deliver presents

If + present simple

if you are naughty



First Conditional

If + present simple

If it rains,

will + infinitive

we will have the party inside



First Conditional

If + present simple

If it rains,

might + infinitive

we **might** have the party inside



First Conditional

If + present simple

If it rains,

may + infinitive

we **may** have the party inside



First Conditional

have the party inside

As soon as you
are good,

EVENT B

I will buy you some sweets

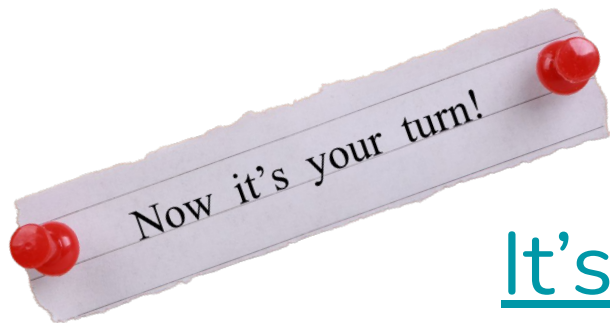

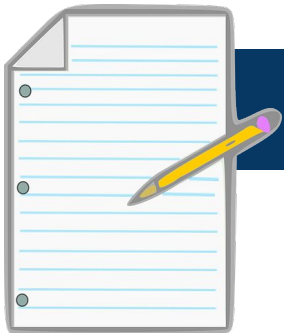
