








In is <u>used</u> to talk about a very specific period of time from now to a future event.




We are going to go on holiday in 3 days





On is <u>used</u> as a preposition of time and can be used to talk about future events. It can only be used with days, dates and 1-day events.

Tuesday 24th July Christmas Day

They are going to have lunch with us on Christmas Day



Tomorrow is used to talk about the next day.

I am going to have a date tomorrow





Later is used to talk about the same day but later in the day.

We're going to have dinner <u>later</u>






Today is used to talk about a future event that is upcoming later in the day.

They're going to come to our house today



This is used to talk about an upcoming future time. It is often used to replace "next".
