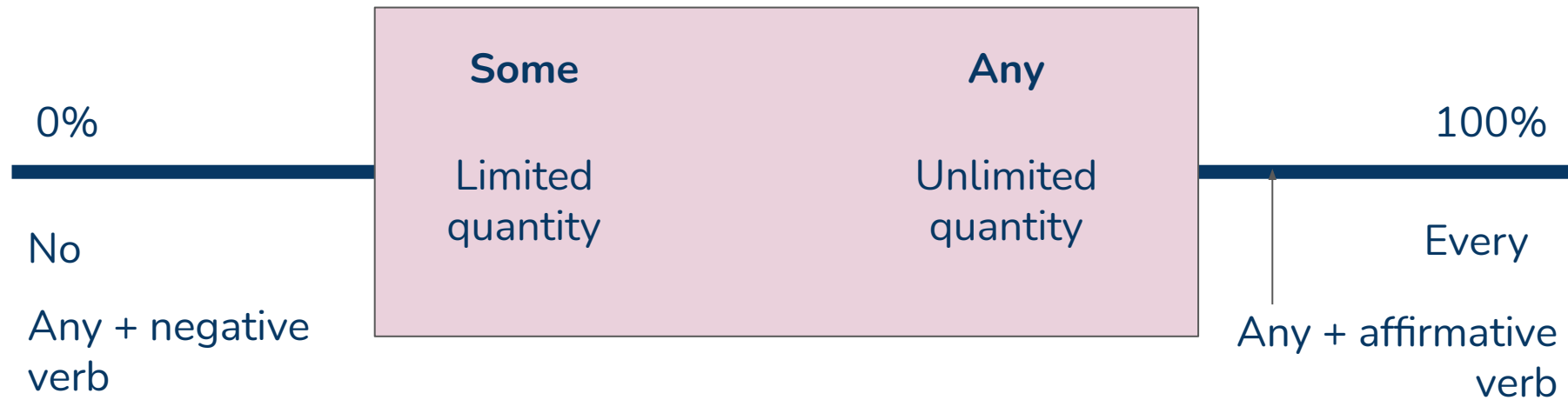

Indefinite pronoun function

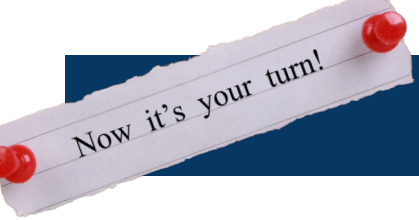


Replaces the position of a noun (subject in a question)



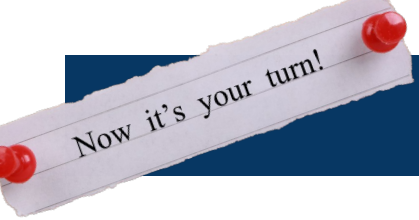

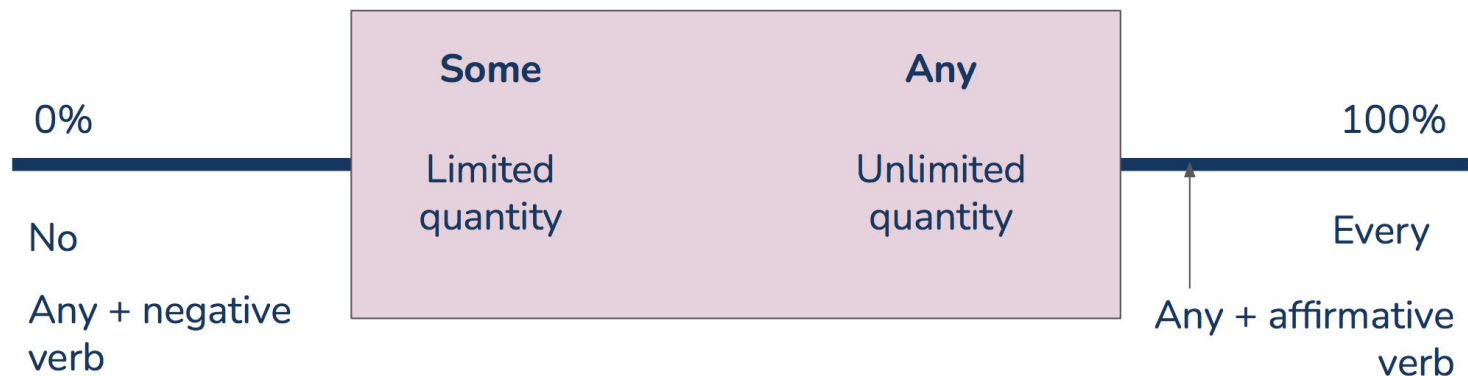

There was **nobody/no one** on the train, it was empty!

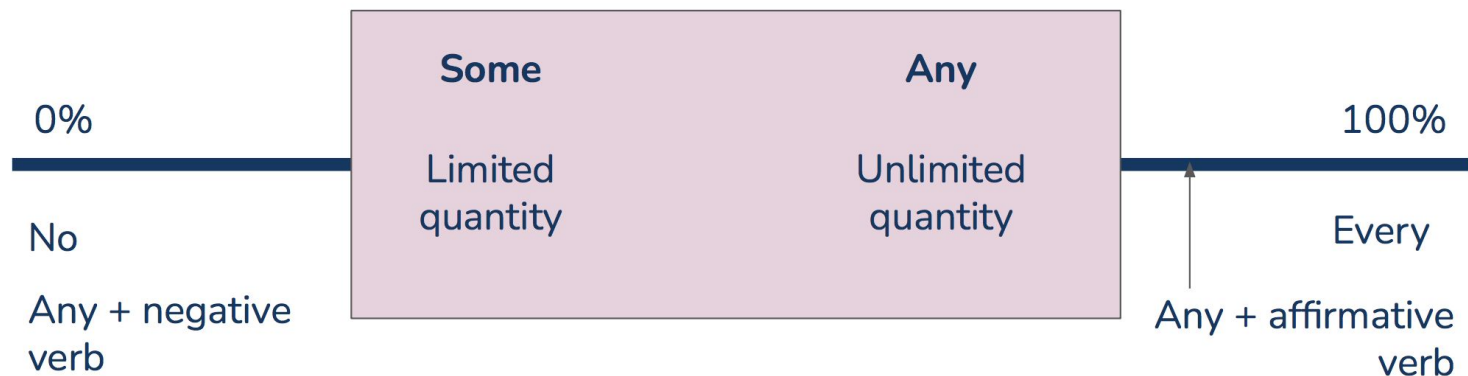

I promise you, there is **nothing** wrong with your computer, it's fine!

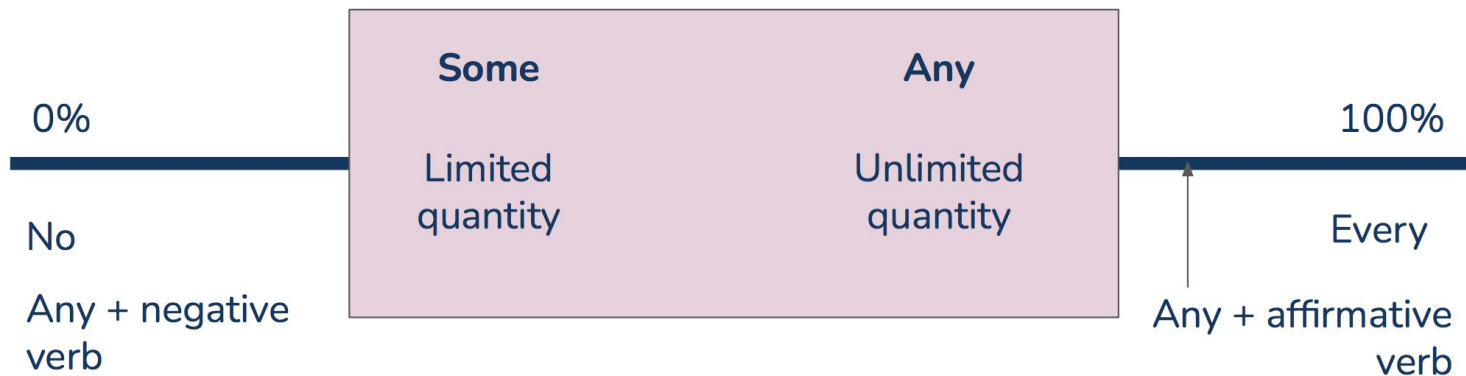

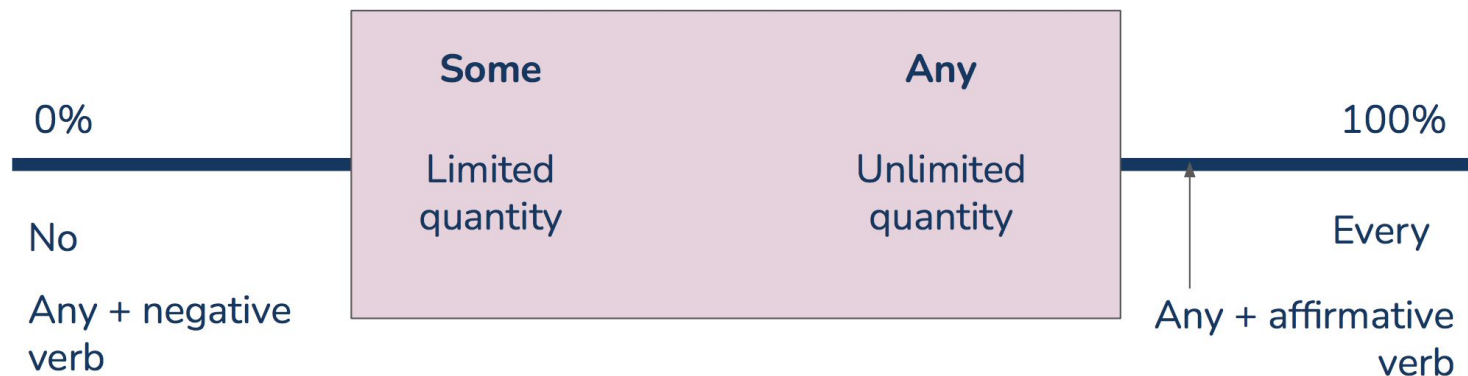

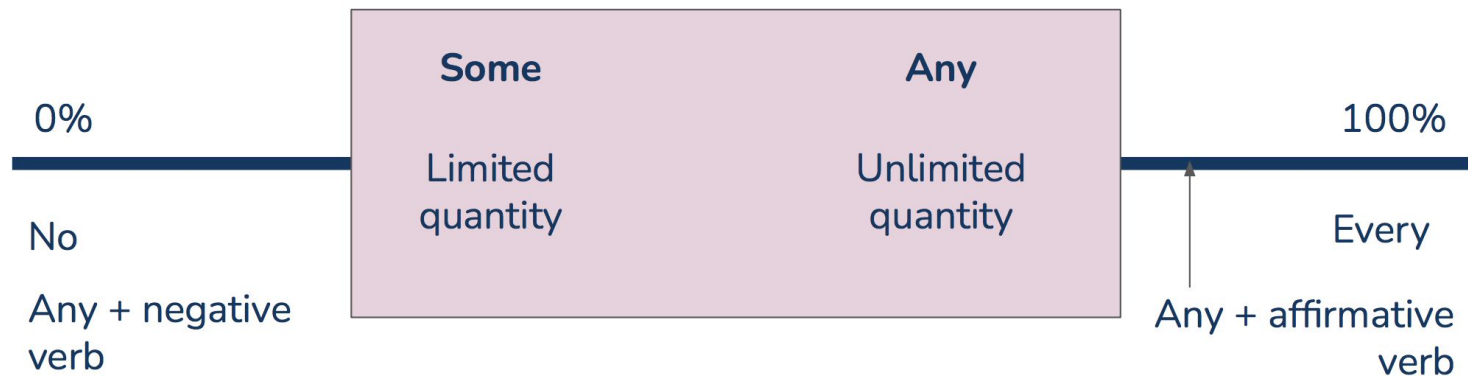

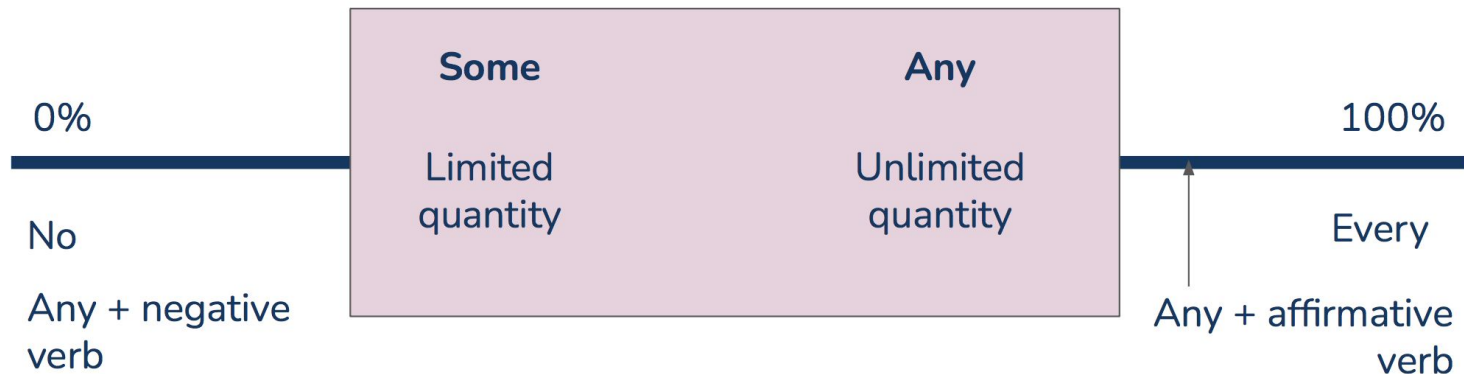

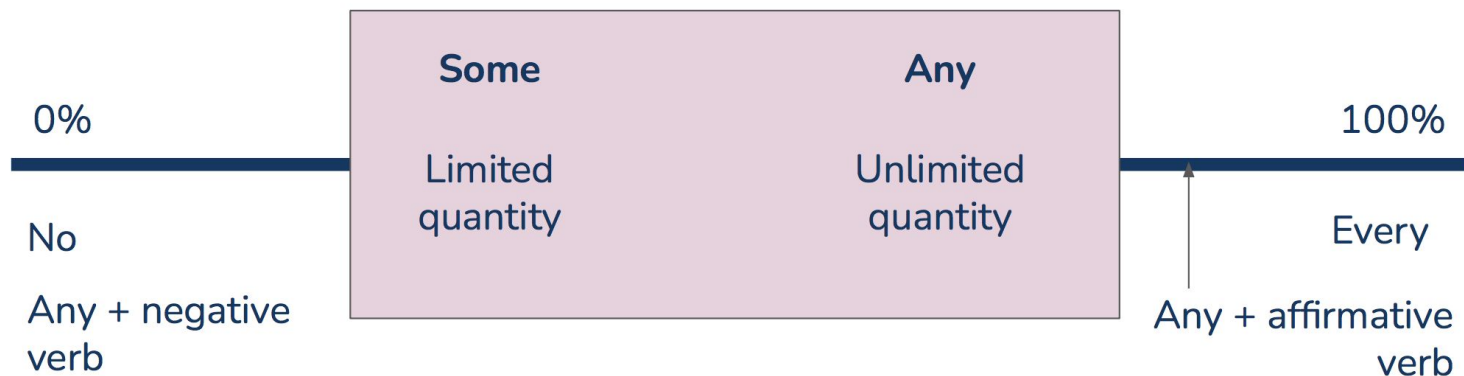


# Indefinite Pronouns

she was so sad.

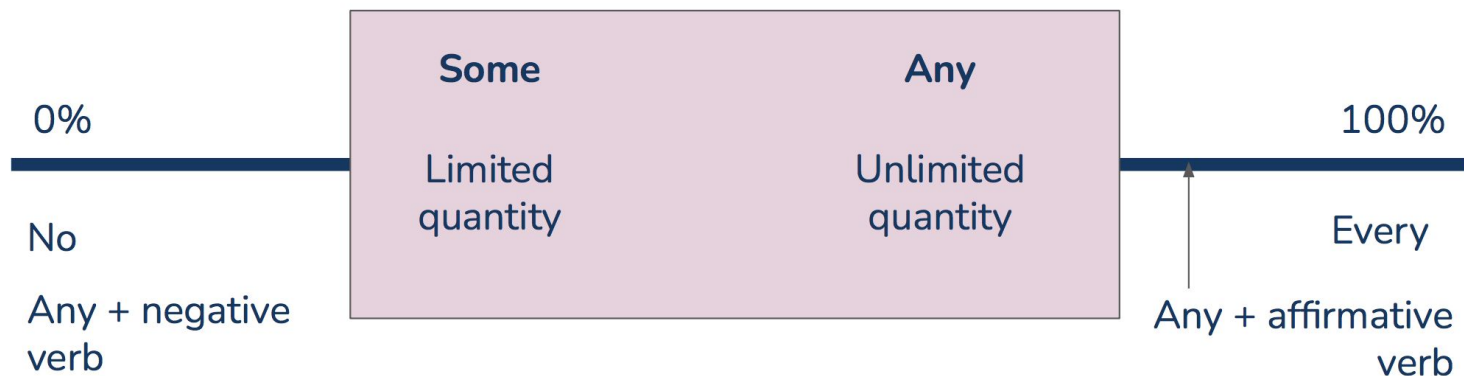


# Indefinite Pronouns

I didn't know who it was.



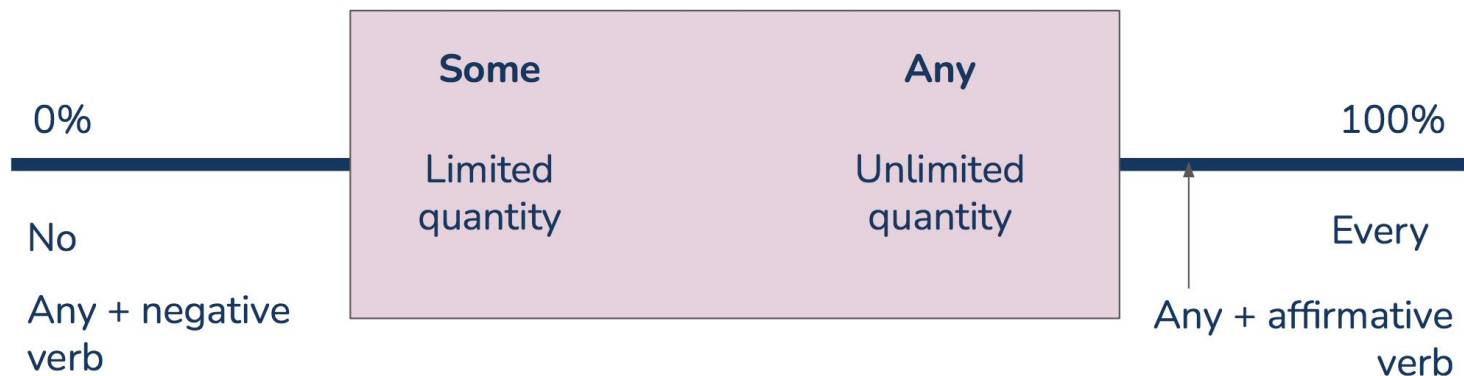
# Indefinite Pronouns

I have looked **everywhere** for my pen but I still can't find it.

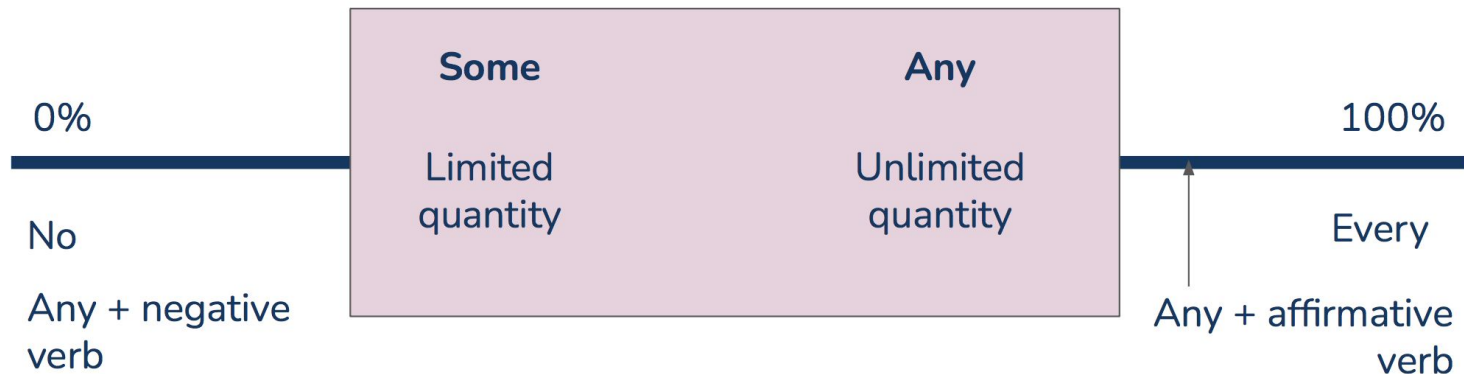

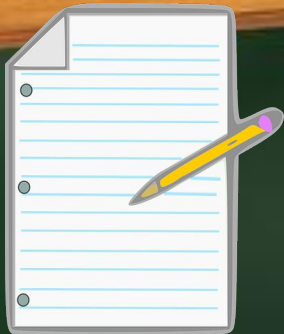
