*How much + uncountable noun  
(quantity)*

**How much** do the bananas cost?

*How much + any noun (price) -  
verb “cost”*

 How **many** your shoes are clean?

 How **much** this cake have you eaten?

# Much and Many

 How many **of** your shoes are clean?

 How much **of** this cake have you eaten?

- 1) Article (a, an, some, the)
- 2) Demonstrative adjective (this, that, these, those)
- 3) Possessive adjective (my, your, his, her, its, our, their)
- 4) Object pronouns (me, you, him, her, it, us, them)

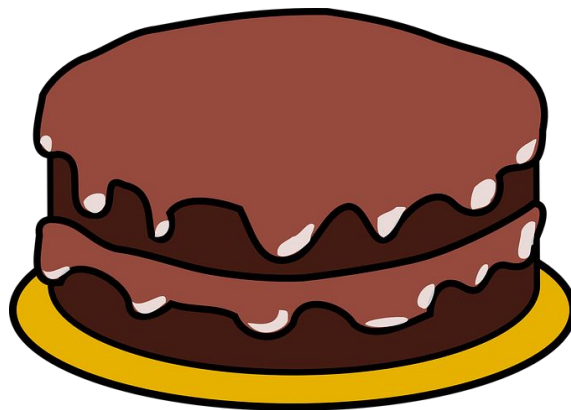

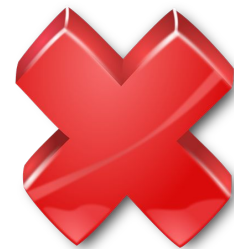

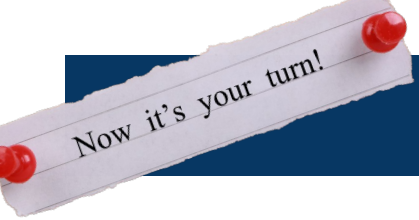
***If an article, demonstrative, possessive adjective or pronoun precedes the noun, we must use “of”***

# Much and Many

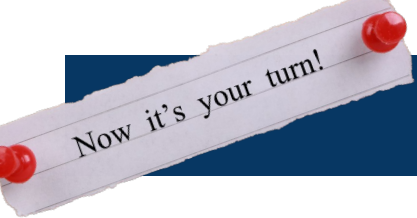
1 sheep

How many sheep are in the field?

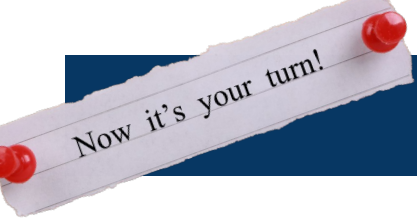

1 man → 2 men, 10 men

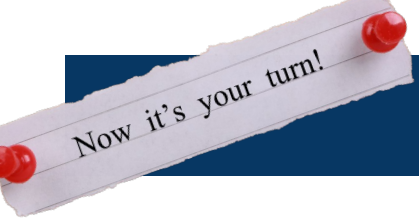
1 woman → 2 women, 10 women
