Sentence Stress

To stress/emphasise something in English, we need to:



- Make a longer sound
- Make a louder sound
- Use a higher pitch
- Make a clearer and more enunciated sound
- Use more facial movement

Main Verb	do, play, go, see	Preposition	in, on, at, to, up
Negative Auxiliary Verb	can't, don't, won't, shouldn't	Conjunction	but, and, because
Affirmative Auxiliary Verb	do, can, must, have to	Interjection	wow, ah, ouch, oops
Articles	a, an, some, the	Interrogative	who, what, where, when

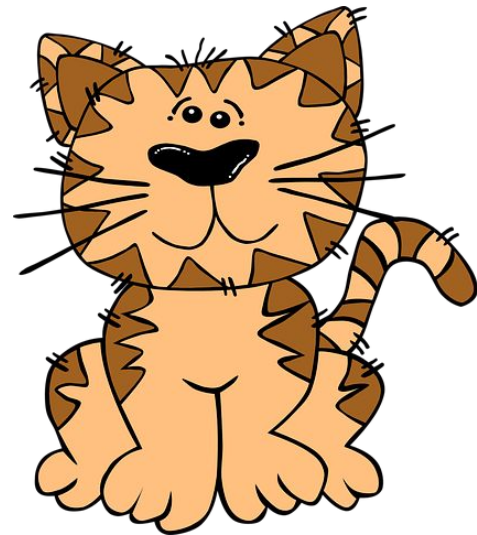

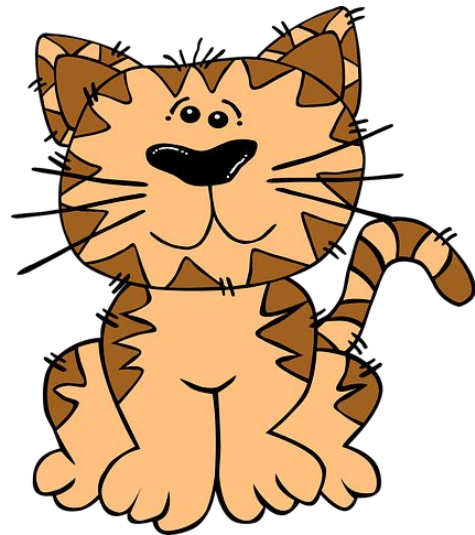
