







The past simple is used to talk about a specific event in the past that has finished whilst the present perfect tense is used to talk about unfinished events or past events with no time.



The past simple tense can be represented like this on a timeline.





The past simple tense has six main uses.

Past Simple Use	Example Sentences
One single past event	I went to Germany in summer
A past duration	I lived in Barcelona for 3 years
A repeated past event	I drove to work every day
A changed state	She was short as a child but now she's tall
A series of past events	I woke up, got dressed, had breakfast then went to school
Stative verbs	I wanted some chocolate yesterday

The present perfect tense can be represented like this on a timeline.





The present perfect tense has six uses.

Present Simple Use	Example Sentences
Life experience (no time)	I have visited France before
Recent past events	We've just arrived home
Change in state	I have improved my English
Past events impact present	I've lost my wallet and I need it now
Unfinished duration of time	I haven't been to the cinema this year
Stative verbs	I have known her for a long time






The past simple shows this event started and finished in the past, now you don't know her.





Past Simple	Present Perfect
I knew her for 5 years	I have known her for 5 years

The present perfect shows this event started 5 years ago and you still know her know. This will continue in the future.

I studied at school for 3 years	I have studied at school for 3 years




We must remember to use the past simple when somebody has died.





Past Simple	Present Perfect

The present perfect expresses this event is continuing to the present (the person is still alive).


The past simple is used to talk about a simple finished event in the past that has no impact on the present time.





Past Simple	Present Perfect
I lost my wallet!	I've lost my wallet and I need it now

When a past event impacts the present time, we use the present perfect tense.





Here is an alternative example with the same difference.

Past Simple	Present Perfect
I broke my ankle	I have broken my ankle so I can't play football
Broke ankle	Broke ankle NOW




The past simple is used to talk about a simple finished event in the past, with a finished time phrase (in 2003)





Past Simple	Present Perfect
I went to France in 2003	I've been to France before

The present perfect is used to talk about life experience (with no time phrase) or an unfinished time (such as before - possibility of changing in the future).





Here is an alternative example with the same difference.

Past Simple	Present Perfect
I lived in Barcelona last year	I have lived in Barcelona before
last year this year lived in Barcelona	At some unknown point, lived in Barcelona
