transitive - separable

To be in a neat small shape

Let's fold up these tops.

to hang up

transitive - separable

To use a hanger or hook

Can you hang my coat up, please?

Phrasal Verbs for Clothing Design

to wear out

transitive - separable

To use so much it breaks/damages

I've worn out these jeans!

Phrasal Verbs for Clothing Design

to put on

transitive - separable

To place on your body

Should I put this shirt on?

Phrasal Verbs for Clothing Design

to take off

transitive - separable

To remove from your body

Should I take this shirt off?

Phrasal Verbs for Clothing Design

to try on

transitive - separable

To temporarily wear to see if it looks good

Would you like to try this dress on?

to do up

transitive - separable

To add decoration to look more expensive

I'd like to do this t-shirt up




