# Questions At The Till

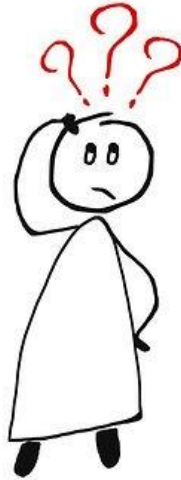

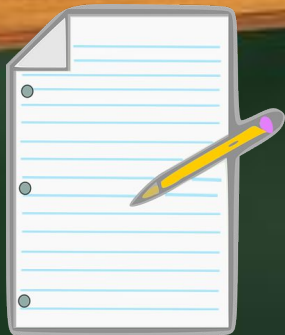
