A quantifier is a little word that gives us an imprecise quantity of a noun.



# Where is a quantifier in a sentence?



Quantifiers are typically placed immediately before a noun.


I drink a lot of tea





Quantifiers are used in a very specific way. They must adapt to the noun that follows. They adapt in three ways; quantity, countability, form.

# Quantity This could be small or large




Countability This could be; Countable - singular Countable - plural Uncountable


