

Will → Would

Present perfect → past perfect

"I have visited France" she said




She said that she had visited France



Present perfect continuous → past perfect continuous

"I have been reading this book" he said



He said that he had been reading that book



Past simple → past perfect

"I went to town yesterday" she said

She said that she had gone to town the day before



Past perfect

"I had gone to town before that" she said

She said that she had gone to town before that



Can → could

"I can't dance" he said

He said that he couldn't dance



Might → may

"I might see you later" he said



He said that he may see me later



Must → Had to

"We must finish our homework" they said



They said that they had to finish their homework





today




that day

ago



tomorrow




the next day

The day after tomorrow




in two days' time


