### What is a conditional?

# How many conditional forms do we have in English?



A conditional is a very special type of sentence in English. It is used to express that an action happens based on a condition. In other words, event B (the result) only happens if event A (the condition) happens.



There are five types of conditional sentences in English;

**Zero Conditional** 

**First Conditional** 

**Second Conditional** 

**Third Conditional** 

Mixed Conditional



Each of these conditional sentences uses a different structure (different tenses) to express a different sequence of events.



Conditional sentences also include a conditional conjunction. The most common conditional conjunctions are **IF** and **WHEN**, which is what we'll use in this course today.



## If I won the lottery, I would buy a new house

Could + infinitive

If I won the lottery, I could buy a new house





Might + infinitive

If I won the lottery, I might buy a new house





If it won the lottery, I could/might buy a new house


